

Non-Owned Aircraft Checklist

Instructor Requirements in non LE Aviation aircraft – All flight instructors flying in non LE Aviation aircraft shall obtain a certificate of insurance, naming LE Aviation, Inc. as additional insureds on customer's aircraft Hull and Liability insurance policy. This additional insured coverage shall be primary and non-contributory with any hull or liability insurance coverage carried by LE Aviation, Inc. This document shall be placed in the students' folder prior to any flights. Written approval must be granted by the Chief Flight instructor prior to flying any non LE Aviation aircraft. A thorough checkout in the aircraft is required and a basic inspection must be performed by maintenance personnel to verify the aircraft is airworthy condition and all inspections and AD's are complied with. Instructors are not allowed to instruct in Experimental Aircraft, or aircraft with non-standard airworthiness certificates.
