

## Student Pilot Solo Checklist

Complete appropriate section for each solo flight

- Is the student at least 16 years of age?
- Does the student have the required insurance coverage and a copy in the training folder?
- Does the student have their student pilot certificate, medical certificate, government issued photo I.D., and logbook on their person?
- Have you verified the completion of the Jeppesen pre-solo written exam, aircraft ground and flight checkout documentation, and are corrected to 100% and are in the student's folder?
- Have you verified full stop landings and pre-solo maneuvers (61.87(d)) have been completed in the last 15 days?
- Have you reviewed the importance of maintaining centerline, go-around procedures, and that all landings are to be made to a full stop/taxi back?
- Is the current and forecast weather within LEA solo student tolerances and the limitations on the student's endorsements?
- Have you reviewed NOTAMS and TFRs pertaining to the flight with the student?
- Have you reviewed what the procedure is if a student encounters a squawk mid-flight?
- Have you covered diversion procedures and available alternates if necessary?
- Have you verified an instructor will be available to debrief at the completion of the flight?

***For solo flight in the vicinity of training airport: Verify that the student has the following endorsements, that the endorsements are current, and that the student understands their limitations for the flight:***

- Solo flight in make and model on the back of student pilot certificate 61.87(n)(1)
- Pre-solo aeronautical knowledge endorsement 61.87(b)
- Pre-solo flight training endorsement 61.87(c)
- Solo authorization endorsement 61.87(n)(2)
- If applicable, Solo authorization endorsement for 15 day currency 61.87(n)(2)

***For a one-time solo flight to another airport within 25 NM of the point of departure: Verify that the Student has the following endorsements, that the endorsements are current, and that the student understands their limitations for the flight:***

- Meet the requirements listed for solo flight in the vicinity of the training airport
- Have **you personally** provided flight training in both directions to include entering and exiting the traffic pattern, with landings at that specific airport
- Solo authorization endorsement to another airport to practice take-offs and landings 61.93(b)(1)(ii)

***For cross country solo flight (any flight greater than 25 NM from the airport from where the flight originated):  
Verify that the Student has the following endorsements, that the endorsements are current, and that the student understands their limitations for the flight:***

- Meet the requirements listed for solo flight in the vicinity of the training airport
- Solo cross-country endorsement on the back of the student pilot certificate with category authorization 61.93(c)(1)
- Solo cross-country endorsement authorizing solo cross-country in make and model of aircraft in student pilot logbook 61.93(c)(2)
- Logbook Each flight (route and limitations) 61.93(c)(2)(ii)

***For repeated solo flights to another airport within 50 NM of the point of departure: Verify that the Student has the following endorsements, that the endorsements are current, and that the student understands their limitations for the flight:***

- Meet the requirements listed for solo flight in the vicinity of the training airport
- Have **you personally** provided flight training in both directions to include entering and exiting the traffic pattern, with landings at that specific airport
- Repeated solo authorization endorsement to another airport to practice take-offs and landings 61.93(b)(2)(ii)
- Solo cross-country endorsement on the back of the student pilot certificate with category authorization 61.93(c)(1)
- Solo cross-country endorsement authorizing solo cross-country in make and model of aircraft in student pilot logbook 61.93(c)(2) [This endorsement need not be repeated provided flights are made to this airport only]

***For solo flight in Class B airspace: Verify that the Student has the following endorsements:  
(Both of the Class B airspace endorsements must be renewed within 90 Days preceding the solo flight activity)***

- Meet the requirements listed for solo flight in the vicinity of the training airport
- Solo flight in Class B airspace 61.95(a)
- Solo flight to, from, or at and an airport located in Class B airspace 61.95(b)
